

Every time I sit down to share what God has been doing since my latest report, I am overwhelmed with things to share. **Thank you for your prayers and involvement** in the work, even from a distance. Every Sunday, we have been having between five and ten visitors and the attendance has been between 40 -50. As a congregation, we have stagnated in our numerical growth because of our meeting place. We are still using one of two hotel meeting rooms. One holds only 50 and the other holds up to 70. We are fervently praying for a larger and **more permanent meeting place**, one which also holds more people and has a separate room for children's classes. Please join us in prayer for that need.

Recent **church activities**, like a congregational outing to the beach on a national holiday, have been a great opportunity to allow the visitors to get to know the church. Many family members of our Christian brothers and sisters have opened up to the gospel and are studying the Bible with us. One of the ladies from the advanced English class has started coming to my apartment on a weekly basis to study the Bible. God is really opening new doors to reach out in **evangelistic opportunities**. I hope you have the opportunity to meet all of these people someday, encourage them and be encouraged by them. **Juan Carlos Caruci**, the brother of Evelyn (one of the sisters with whom I study weekly), was especially encouraged by the recent all-nighter we had for the youth and Sunday, March 19, he put on Christ in baptism!



There are several spouses of our members who are not yet Christians. The monthly activities for the married couples have been a positive opportunity to reach out to them. Their February event was a romantic Valentine's dinner served by some of us singles. Often on the Saturdays that there is an activity for the married couples, I am able to accept invitations for speaking engagements in other parts of the nation. After giving a **class on depression and discouragement** in the city of Barquisimeto in early February, the ladies in East Caracas requested that I teach the class here, apart from our regular monthly ladies' Bible studies. Four of the five visitors that evening were former or current English Class students (pictured right). The last Saturday in March, I traveled to Cabudare with Zulmelly, one of the non-Christian young ladies in the East Caracas congregation. I was invited to give a **class to the ladies** on Dedication to God during a day of congregational fasting.



My newsletter wouldn't be complete without mentioning my time in Bogotá in February. Unfortunately, because of the forced timing of my visa renewal, my **trip to Bogotá** prevented me from attending the area-wide worship service in Central Venezuela, attended by almost 500 people on Sunday, February 19. While in Bogotá, God used Daniel Mata, a Venezuelan preacher, and me (pictured teaching below) in a weekend seminar sponsored by the Memorial Church of Christ in Houston, Texas. We held classes in four different congregations throughout the city. This was in addition to the personal and group Bible studies I held with other ladies in north Bogotá during my week-long visit.
